

## Change of Status - Canadian:

# Post Approval Checklist

### Step 1: Complete I-9 - For New Employment

- Complete Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, if you will be starting work with a new employer.
- You will need your valid:
  - Passport
  - I-94 - A new I-94 is issued every time you enter the U.S.

### Step 2: Request Social Security Number (SSN) - If No SSN

- Apply for a Social Security Number and Card, if you do not already have one.
- You will need your valid:
  - Passport
  - I-94

### Step 3: Carry Documents For Re-entry Into The U.S. - The Next Time You Travel Abroad

Next time you travel abroad after the “Change of Status” effective date:

- You will need to carry your valid:
  - Canadian Passport
  - I-797A Approval Notice
  - 2-3 Recent Pay Statements from Employer Listed on I-797A Approval Notice
- Your Canadian Dependents will need to carry their valid:
  - Canadian Passport
  - I-797A Approval Notice
  - Marriage Certificate (for Spouse)
  - Birth Certificate (for Child)
- Your Non-Canadian Dependents will need to carry the documents listed above, and:
  - Apply For A Visa Stamp

### Step 4: Review I-94

- View your new I-94 on the I-94 - Official Website.
- Contact U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) promptly if there is an error.
